PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall Independent School District Number 125 of Kay County, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000) to provide funds to be issued in series for the purpose of purchasing transportation equipment and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in such District sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest not to exceed the rate of ten (10%) percentum per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within five (5) years from their date?

Shall Independent School District Number 125 of Kay County, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) to provide funds to be issued in series for the purpose of purchasing transportation equipment to include an activity bus and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in such District sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest not to exceed the rate of ten (10%) percentum per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within five (5) years from their date?
